As per my email exchange with you dated 12/01/2012, I indicated that Straits Resources Limited "Straits" and Infigen Energy have now settled on an amicable arrangement going forward and required information from your department on the best method to have the objection removed from the register.

Straits appreciate the response received, advising the submission has already occurred and is in the public domain (on your web-site) and it could not be removed and, Straits could have their status changed from "objects" to "comments" or "supports" and you would require a supplementary submission stating our new position on the wind farm.

Straits at the time of the objection reserved their rights to remove the objection to the proposed Flyers Creek Windfarm, Project Application Number 08_0252 and will remain open to accepting an agreed executed Term Sheet from Infigen Energy.

Since reaching an amicable agreement between Straits and Infigen Energy, Straits have given a commitment to Infigen Energy, to request NSW Department of Planning & Infrastructure to change the position from an objection to supporting the Flyers Creek Windfarm, Project Application Number 08_0252.

Straits respect the confidentiality of the executed term sheet between Straits and Infigen and therefore reserve the right not to release its contents as supporting evidence to have our position changed from object to supports. It would be appreciated if this letter can be treated as sufficient for the necessary change.
