As the Environmental Impact Statement has just been released by the ROADS & MARITIME SERVICE DEPARTMENT (SEPTEMBER, 2019), our concerns would be "TRAFFIC NOISE", "AIR POLLUTION", and the "ENVIRONMENT", during construction and completion of the COFFS HARBOUR BYPASS.

We demand a "DUST MONITOR" and a "NOISE MONITOR" to be installed during construction, as a "HEALTH PRECAUTION MEASUREMENT".

THE HON. SIR DAVID ATTENBOROUGH, has stated many times, we must look after the "ENVIRONMENT", and take drastic action now, otherwise it will be gone forever.

We have a corridor of trees along the creek bank of HIGHLANDER DRIVE, NORTH BOAMBEE VALLEY, where many animals call home, E.G. KOALA BEARS, ECHIDNAS, FROGS, WILD TURKEYS, LIZARDS, GOANNAS and SNAKES.
