Coffs Harbour Bypass

Below is the feedback in relation to our recent meeting. We would like this information included as a submission. I would like our following concerns of the Coffs Harbour bypass project's impact of Kororo Public School community, discussed and responded to.

- We like the idea that the bridge is now closer to the school and a lit up carpark is being provided on the other side of the highway and there is no area for trucks to pull over.
- We like the position of the bus bay area.
- We request the name of the bridge remain as the "Luke Bowen" Bridge.
- There needs to be a sign to inform drivers that the carpark is for staff only.
- There needs to be barriers between all roads and students.
- We would expect the road speed would be 40 km an hour directly in front of the school and bus bays.
- There needs to be lighting in all carpark areas as we have meetings and functions at night and the carpark is a good distance from the school- including the teacher's carpark and along the road to the south.
- As the carpark is quite a distance from the school we would expect shelter to be provided along the path and at the Kiss and Drop zone for pedestrians.
- The entry area for delivery needs to be larger as we would need more than 2 carparks.
