Thank you for giving me the opportunity to respond to your letter of 23 September 2019.

I am not at all worried about the development concerned, but I do however have one thought that I believe is important.

When the highway was built to bypass Goulburn, the only southward access to the south bound lanes was put at the southern end of Goulburn. The northern end of Goulburn only has access to the north bound lanes.

This means that any industries, and cars, have to travel right through the streets of Goulburn, till they can access the south bound lanes.

l believe that the State Government has given Goulburn Mulwaree Council funding to develop the Sinclair Street area for industrial use, and I have no worry with that, but industries such as the poultry processing will generate a lot of truck traffic, both to the south as well as the north, and all those trucks will have to travel past large tracts of housing and retail premises to get to the south bound highway. This will cause a lot of noise and worry for residents, as well as road maintenance for the council.

I feel that it is now imperative to build a south bound access at the northern end of Goulburn. The northern end of Goulburn cannot be allowed to grow without one.
