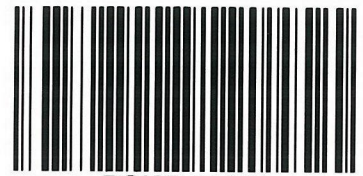

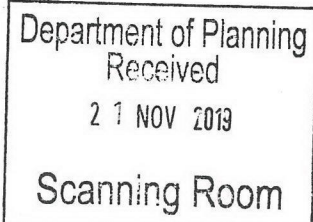

I wish to make known my ideas and concerns regarding the Amended Redevelopment plans for Greenwich Hospital currently on exhibition by the proponent, HammondCare.

In particular I OBJECT to the following aspects:

- **SIZE, BULK AND SCALE OF THE MAIN HOSPITAL TOWER BUILDING** for the following reasons:

At several storeys high it would result in loss of light & physical aspect for many Greenwich residents; a positive result could be produced if the number of storeys could be reduced.

- **SERVICED SENIORS LIVING Apartment Blocks** for the following reasons:

Potential overcrowding/overshadowing.
