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I previously made a submission and am disappointed that the issues raised still apply.

- 1. Seniors' residential towers should not be on the western side of a steeply sided bushland reserve, as this is terrain at particular risk from wildfire/ climate change. This was highlighted by catastrophic danger to Sydney on 12 December. As a senior and reasonably able resident of Northwood, I know the anxiety of fire danger, and am seriously concerned at the possible risk to life of aged and frail residents.
- 2. The visual bulk of the proposal remains, and will tower over the skyline of Northwood.
- 3. This land is zoned for Health purposes, not for residential purposes. It should not be alienated from future possible health uses.
- 4. The proposed removal of trees will cause inevitable damage to E2 zone bushland. Local residents cherish this beautiful valley.
- 5. Increased traffic flow on River Road will will cause increased risk to children and others accessing Greenwich Public School.
