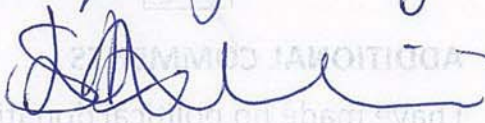
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business that is fully established for everyone who is in the community and beyond. The thought-
