I am really concerned about the planned solar farms around Jindera.

The following are my issues:

- Prime farming land being taken out of the agricultural system for at least 30 years. In this area the land is head per acre of stock. Why are these solar farms not going out to the areas where the stock ratio is acres per head and little/no residents?
- Not enough known to know if the land will be contaminated and for what time frame
- The concentration of solar farms and number of panels in a small area – no-one knows enough to know if there is a health risk involved to residents living within a prescribed area.
