CASA has briefly reviewed the Architectural Drawings.

It appears that the taller building 2A will be RL 135.9m.

From the information provided and previous assessments in the area, the building will be in the vicinity of the edge of the Outer Horizontal Surface for Sydney Airport. In any case, the height of the Outer Horizontal Surface is RL 156m. Therefore, the building should not infringe prescribed airspace and will not be an 'obstacle' in aviation terms. Sydney Airport <u>AirspaceProtection@syd.com.au</u> would be able to confirm that the building will not be an obstacle.

Therefore CASA does not need to assess the building under the Airspace Regulations. CASA has no objection to the development.

In future, it is possible that the tower cranes used to construct the building could infringe prescribed airspace and therefore require Approval under the Airspace Regulations. Again, Sydney Airport would be able to confirm whether the cranes will infringe prescribed airspace (and describe the Approval process).
