I object to these modifications, on merit and on principle because:

1. The existing infrastructure will not be able to handle the additional traffic. The roads surrounding the M5 in this area constantly need maintenance due to trucks using Newbridge and Nuwarra roads to avoid paying the M5 toll. The intersection where the trucks turn out of Nuwarra road and onto Heathcote Rd is at the entrance to The Wattle Grove/Holsworthy estate and is already a known blackspot.
