I object to these modifications, on merit and on principle because of the PAC further conditions, key issues of traffic, noise and air quality. As a disability pensioner I am grievously concerned, disturbed and anxious regarding the increase in traffic through additional truck movements, increase in noise from those truck movements and the crushing and processing of imported soil and potential waste to the site, and finally the potential hazardous decrease in air quality from contaminants contained within the imported soil and potential waste.

Furthermore I am greatly disturbed by the lack of due process being implemented by all parties concerned through the acceptance of this amendment to the original proposal, when it is clear that this in no way represents a further amendment but is entirely a construction factor of the original proposal. In this case it has been deliberately removed from the original proposal and subsequent community consultation. Intentionally this key construction requirement has been submitted as an amendment at this later date rather than submitting a new proposal plan subject to community consultation.
