**Enirgi Battery Recycling Facility MOD 1 (SSD-6619-Mod-1)  
Environmental Assessment**

I refer to your email of 27 November 2019 to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) Water and the Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR) about the above matter.

The following advice for you to consider is from DPIE Water and NRAR. Please note Crown Lands, the Department of Primary Industries (DPI) – Fisheries and DPI - Agriculture all now provide a separate response directly to you.

Prior to project determination

- The proponent should provide confirmation of the ability to meet the additional water demands for the project.

Post project determination

- The proponent should prepare the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan as part of the CEMP in consultation with DPIE Water prior to the commencement of activities.
- The proponent should provide confirmation for the option of treated water to sewer (via a trade waste agreement) should Wagga Wagga City Council install the service in the future or alternatively provide advice on how the trade waste will be disposed of, and provide evidence of this.
