- Plumbers & Building Maintenance
- Professional services
- Recruitment Services and Labour Hire
- Signwriters and signage suppliers
- Site facilities and temporary services (power, water, telecommunications etc.)

- Structural concrete foundations
- Suppliers of tools, hardware, engineering supplies, safety equipment and construction consumables
- Temporary and permanent buildings supply
- Training Providers (RTO's) particularly construction safety training and high voltage training
