Further to our submission dated 1 September, 2018, we have been advised of a factual error in our comments which we'd like to correct.

We stated, erroneously, that there would be an extension to the nightclub and wish to withdraw our reference to this. We would also like to emphasise that The Star maintains a high level of security within its premises where it has jurisdiction. The Star makes every effort to keep anti-social behaviour to a minimum outside the premises, even though its security staff have no jurisdiction there. We have been seeking the establishment of a 24-hour police facility at, or near The Star, for many years, and are aware that The Star management is supportive of this proposal and has been in discussion with the Local Area Command. We strongly recommend that the Government work with the Star and LAC to implement this proposal.

Anti-social behaviour near The Star is often attributed to The Star but occurs when party boats disembark often drunken passengers from the wharf directly opposite The Star. They can become aggressive when denied entrance to the 24-hour facility.

We trust that this supplementary submission can be considered together with our original submission.
