Description of proposal

The above State significant development (SSD) application and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was exhibited from 2 April 2020 until 29 April 2020. The Applicant has submitted a Response to Submission (RtS) and a Supplementary Response to Submissions (SRtS) that respond to the comments made in submissions lodged by government agencies and the public.

The following amendments to the development are also proposed:

- Relocation of the proposed Parish Church and associated alterations to landscaping works.
 - Upgrades and alterations to two existing driveways providing access from Darcy Road.
 - Provision of Out-of-School-Hours care.
 - Creation of a pedestrian access from Farmhouse Road and additional through-site pedestrian links.
