I object to the proposal, for the following reason(s):

1. Limited traffic flow on Majara Street, this will cause congestion and parking problems
2. The limitations a High School will place on the use of the Mike Sherd Oval, The oval will become prescribed premises and therefore a prohibited area. Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 No 33, <https://legislation.nsw.gov.au/view/whole/html/inforce/current/act-1901-033>
3. The Oval is Crown land.
4. The heightened risk of damage to the local Cenotaph.
5. The encroachment on to the Bungendore Common (almost one of the last left in NSW).
6. The removal of the locally funded swimming pool in favour of a swimming pool outside of town next to a sewage/water treatment plant.
7. The insertion of a modernistic prefabricated School in a position that will negatively effect an area that of historic significance, which include the Covent, where St Mary Mckillop was known to stayed, the Station Masters house, The Railway station, The original Gate Keepers cottage, Post office, Police station, and Original Cobb & Co Stable. A negative impact on the Architecture and esthetic appearance of that precinct.
8. The Burial site located in the south east corner of the site.
9. A further reduction of open space such as Parks and Gardens, for recreational facilities.
