Re: Cudgen Lakes Sand Quarry - Modification 2 (MP 05_0103B MOD 2)

Thank you for the opportunity to provide advice on the above matter. This is a response from the NSW Department of Planning & Environment – Division of Resources & Geoscience, Geological Survey of New South Wales (GSNSW).

The proposal seeks to modify the following:

- increase the total extractable resource by 2.2 million cubic metres,
- consolidate the northern and southern extraction areas following the realignment of Altona Drive,
- reduce the overall disturbance footprint of the quarry by approximately 5 hectares,
- reconfigure the long-term use and layout of the processing area,
- increase the slope of the final lake batters,
- extend the life of the quarry from 2029 to 2047 and
- administration amendments to the Project Approval.

GSNSW has no concerns with the modification. The proposed increase will maximise utilisation of the resource.
