Please note Transgrid comments in relation to : 2021- 501 Newstan Mine Extension Project (SSD-10333) - Request for Comment

- i. This is not a customer project.
- ii. Please note- If the project activities has an impact on Transgrid infrastructure/network, then customer needs to submit the MPA to assess any impact/modification to the Transgrid network.
- iii. In relation to the EIS, if TransGrid's infrastructure is affected by this extension, it will need to be directed to the Transmission Line and Cables Asset Manager and the Transgrid's Easement Maintenance teams for further consultation relating to subsidence, line deviations of infrastructure (if required) and access requirements. If a line deviation is required, Property alongside the Transgrid Project Manager will assist with facilitating and coordinating the extinguishment and creation of easements with the mining company. We will also need to provide copies of TransGrid's easement guidelines to ensure safety requirements are met.
- iv. Provided that TransGrid's rights to access the transmission lines and the continuity of our easement are protected by way of easement(s), TransGrid does not object to the extension of the mine extension project.
