# Description of the development consent

Expansion of the ash dam and changes to the ash disposal method and ancillary infrastructure.

# Description of proposed modification

The proposed modification involves an increase in ash recycling capacity at Eraring Power Station including:

- Construction and operation of up to four additional 600 tonnes ash storage silos to enable export of up to 150,000 tonnes per annum of stored ash product;
- Integration of ash recycling works approved under local development consent; and
- Construction of ancillary infrastructure to support ash recycling.

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (Department) is exhibiting an application to modify the abovementioned approved State Significant Development (SSD).
