RE: SSD10389 – Liverpool Hospital Redevelopment - Response to Submissions (RTS)

An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) in support of a State Significant Development Application (SSDA) for the construction and operation of a new Integrated Services Building at Liverpool Hospital was publicly exhibited for a period of 28 days inclusive between 28 May 2020 and 25 June 2020 (SSD 10389).
