The site is not mapped as bush fire prone land on the Council's Bush Fire Prone Land Map, however the adjoining Stoney Range Regional Botanic Garden is an area that can support a bush fire.

In this regard, a bush fire assessment report shall be prepared by a suitably qualified person which assesses the proposed development against the requirements of Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2019 providing recommendations.
