Thank you for your email of 19 October 2021. This is a response from the NSW Department of Regional NSW – Mining, Exploration & Geoscience (MEG) – Geological Survey of NSW (GSNSW).

MEG has reviewed the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for Upper South Creek Advanced Water Recycling Centre and as no concerns to raise in relation to the project. MEG notes that the proposed path of the western treated water pipeline transects two Group 5 (structural /brick clay) Exploration Licences (EL) as follows:

MEG notes that Biodiversity Development Assessment Report accompanying the EIS indicates that biodiversity impacts will be offset in accordance with the NSW Biodiversity Offset Scheme through either the establishment of Biodiversity Stewardship Sites (BSS) or through securing credits from the open market. MEG requests consultation in relation to the establishment of any BSS to ensure there is no consequent sterilisation of mineral or extractive resources resulting from the establishment of a BSS.
