I object to this proposed development as a resident living in Avon Road in Pymble.

The school is planning to increase classroom number from existing 12 to 16 for Year 5 and 6 plus a new ELC facility with capacity of 90.

The proposed development will put salt on wound for local residents who need to get out/to home during the already terrible traffic in the rush hour for school drop off and pick up.

The school keeps telling the residents that the school **is not seeking** to increase the school population (e.g. the previous EIS in 2012 and this current EIS).

In reality, the total school population has increased from 2420 in 2012 to 2659 in 2021 and this is not the end.

The current EIS states the school has determined a maximum enrolment of 2650 students plus at least 400 staff, which is more than 3000 in totality.

The school should fix the traffic issue rather than avoid it.

Parking is taken up by PLC P players as PLC is not allowing their students to park inside their car parks, though they said they would. Pictures can be sent. There is no commuter parking left for residents.
