Blacktown Council's submission to SSD 9368 – Modification 4 to Alex Avenue Public School at 95 Farmland Drive, Schofields

1. Engineering issues

a. The changes proposed to conditions D45 and D46 do not appear to completely relate to the delivery of Pelican Road. There is insufficient information to justify these changes and therefore, we do not support these changes.

2. Recreation Planning Design issues

- Insufficient information has been provided regarding Appendix C: Easement
 Management Plan. Recreation Planning Design Section is seeking clarification regarding the following:
 - Detail the specific works to be completed in Easement A and a timeframe for completion.
 - The temporary car park is noted as being required for access to construct Stage 2 as per Figure 10 Page 12. The applicant is to clarify if this means that all Easement A works will not be completed until the completion of the Stage 2 works. More information is required on this matter.

3. Traffic issues

a. Confirmation that the School Transport Coordinator role is to be continued until the program of works is completed. This has been particularly beneficial in addressing issues between the school and Council. Also its continuation is beneficial for sustaining the relationship between the community, the school and for Council.
