## NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

In February 2015, the NSW Government committed funding towards the redevelopment of St George Hospital.

The redevelopment of St George Hospital will meet the growing demand for healthcare services for the South East Sydney community, now and into the future.

The redevelopment includes a seven-storey Acute Services Building above the Gray Street Emergency Department, which was completed in October 2014.

## The new Acute Services Building will include:

- o Intensive care
- o High dependency
- Cardiac intensive care
- Theatre expansion including intraoperative theatres
- Sterilising services department
- Additional acute inpatient beds.

## THE NEXT STAGE - LODGEMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

As a state significant development, the Environmental Impact Statement will be lodged in the coming weeks through the NSW Department of Planning and Environment (DPE). The proposal will be on public exhibition on the DPE website and on display at the Kogarah City Council.
