**Exhibition of Response to Submissions Report - The University of Sydney Campus
Improvement Program State Significant Development (SSD 6123)**

Thank you for your letter dated 4 July 2014, requesting Transport for NSW (TfNSW) to review and comment on the response to submissions for above development. Please accept our letter as a joint Transport for NSW (TfNSW) and Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) comments on the above development application.

The Access Strategy shows Missenden Road as a gateway. Based on the Response to Submissions, TfNSW understands that no formal access road via Missenden Road is proposed at present and that any future connection via Missenden would be subject to agreement with a number of agencies. If in the future, vehicle access is sought from Missenden Road, then a traffic and transport impact assessment should be undertaken to assess the impacts on the following:

- Intersections along Carillon Avenue and Missenden Road.
- Existing bus stops and bus services in this vicinity of the development.
