Here is the human face to this issue. Our house is situated on a family farm 6 km from Wyong NSW. We have lived in our house for 45 years and our family before us.

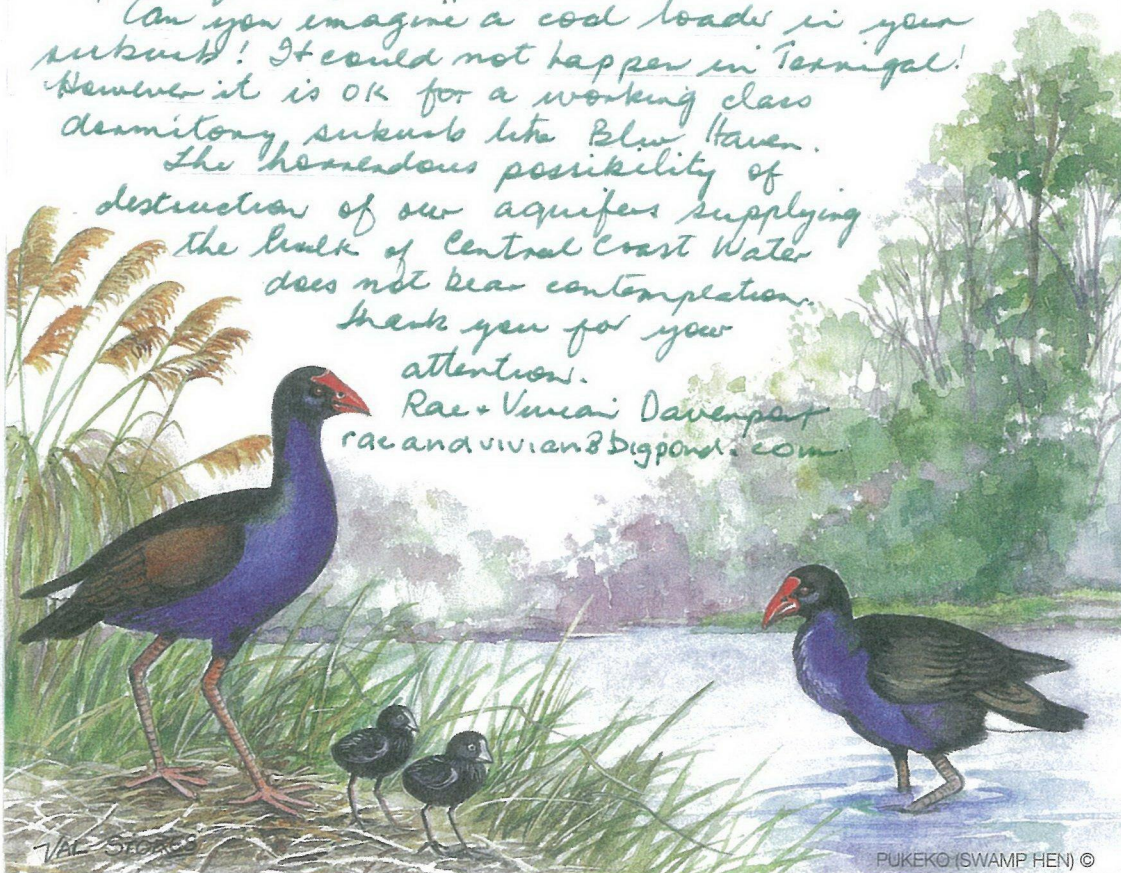
Kores has openly admitted that when they mine coal under our house they will use long wall techniques and on completion our house will drop 1.8 metres. Some local houses are going to drop up to 2.3 metres! You cannot be compensated for this. Cham Valley Bay residents have been waiting 20 years for their compensation.

Can you imagine a coal loader in your suburb! It could not happen in Terrigal! However it is OK for a working class dormitory suburb like Blue Haven.

The horrendous possibility of destruction of our aquifers supplying the bulk of Central Coast Water does not bear contemplation.
