RE: Wallarah 2 Coal Project SSD 4974 Amended Development Application.

We are residence of Jilliby and strongly object to the current ADA on exhibition and also to further progression of the Wallarah 2 Coal Project.

Our residence is a relative new brick home within the mining area and we are very concerned about the effect that the proposed undergrown mine will have on our health, house subsidence, water supply, the environment and general community.

The proposed coal loader and conveyor system will be an eyesore and environmental disaster with excessive polluted dust, noise 24 hours per day as well as extra truck movement on our overcrowded road system especially for the residence of Blue Haven and Wyee. The conveyor system will also landlock Darkinjung ALC land restricting projected developments and therefore threaten hundreds of valuable jobs.

We understand that Kores has a massive debt ratio problem and with very low coal market returns we are very concerned that if the mine goes ahead the Company will cut corners to save money jeopardize safety of its workers, destroy the local environment, our water catchment and cause health problems for local community as well as any hope of compensation or rehabilitation of the area.

There will be very little benefit for the Central Coast, very few local will be employed and industry components will come from outside the area. The NSW Government will sacrifice the health and water supply of the community to please this rouge foreign company for the sake of very small royalty.

This Amendment and the Wallarah 2 Coal Project should be rejected in its entirety as there are too many areas of risk.
