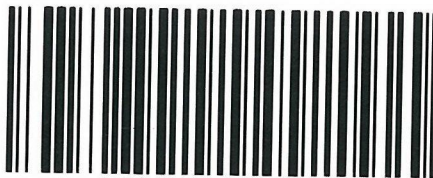

Notice of Exhibition

Benedict Recycling Pty Ltd has submitted a Development Application (DA) and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Smeaton Grange Resource Recovery Facility, located at 52 Anderson Road, Smeaton Grange in the Camden Local Government Area.

You are being notified of the proposal as you have been identified as a neighbouring landowner/occupier.

The proposal involves site establishment works, construction and operation of a resource recovery facility to process up to 140,000 tonnes per annum of non-putrescible waste. Waste to be processed at the site will include building and demolition waste, selected commercial and industrial waste, vegetation, virgin natural excavated material, rail ballast and spoil.

The DA and EIS will be on public exhibition from **Thursday 14 July 2016** until **Friday 26 August 2016**.
