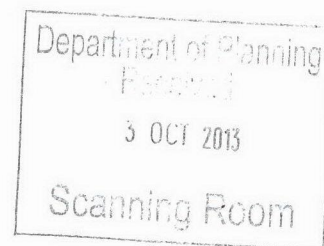
SUBMISSION: ROCKY HILL COAL MINE PROJECT – APPLICATION No. SSD-5156

I wish to express my **opposition** to the Rocky Hill mine project on the following grounds:

- Cumulative impacts on health, through coal dust and contaminated water in rivers from expansion of Yancoal's Stratford open cut mine which if approved, will continue to expand north towards Gloucester township
- Cumulative impacts on rural residential areas, especially Forbesdale, from AGL's Gloucester Coal Seam Gas Project, consisting of a total of 110 gas wells and an 80km pipeline to Hexham in Stage I, 110 gas wells in Stage II and 110 gas wells in Stage III
- Noise and visual impact on this scenic area so close to town
- Coal mining robs NSW of valuable food producing land
- Decline in tourism as Gloucester loses its appeal
- Excessive movement of trucks and heavy mining equipment along The Bucketts Way and Jack's Road, passing Thunderbolts and Avon River Estates
- Difficulty attracting new residents. Gloucester has in the past years, been a haven for 'tree changers'
- Impact on many small businesses, which already have suffered from apprentices leaving to work in Stratford and Duralie mines for higher wages
