

LETTER OF OPPOSITION TO THE PROJECT



I do not want my name published.

I am not a member of any political party nor have I made any donation to any political party or group.

I have made a detailed study of the proposed Rocky Hill open cut coal mine.

I have visited and inspected the proposed site for the mine.

I am of the opinion that the proposed mine is far too close to existing residential housing and the township of Gloucester.

My research indicates the following

- 1 truck movement every 6 minutes from Rocky Hill to Stratford mine along the Avon Valley floor.
- 316,000 fully loaded 60 tonne coal truck movements over 16 years totalling 6.6 million klms.
- Proven health risks associated with coal dust and open cut mining projects
- Adverse effects to tourism, agriculture and lifestyle
- Current outcomes of the effects of mining eg. Singleton open cut mining project. A living and shocking example of the effects of open cut mining on the environment.

For these reasons I totally oppose the Rocky Hill Mining Project.
