I oppose the above projects. As a resident of Taree I am extremely concerned about this proposal. The Manning River is the lifeblood of Taree.

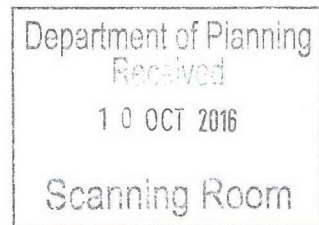
