I am opposed to the Rocky Hill Coal Project and the Stratford Mine Modification.

In Gloucester's main street, the speed limit is 50km/hr. Even though my car can travel much faster than this, I obey the speed limit because travelling at 110km/hr through the main street would be very dangerous and irresponsible. The authorities have this 50km/hr speed limit in place to protect pedestrians and other road users in this built up area. It makes good common sense to have these limits, even though the cars that use them can travel much faster. As we move further from town the speed limits increase and I am able to drive my car faster. But only where it is safe and appropriate to do so. As we travel through other towns and built-up areas there are limits imposed and the car's speed is again restricted to 50 or 60 km/hr.

In the same way as the government looks after the people in the town by imposing safe speed limits, I am looking to the relevant authorities to impose good commonsense rules as to how close an open cut coal mine can be to the town centre.

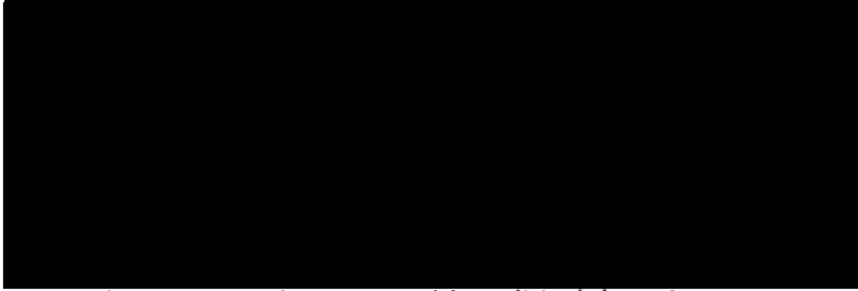
