The railing of the coal to Newcastle is also unacceptable.

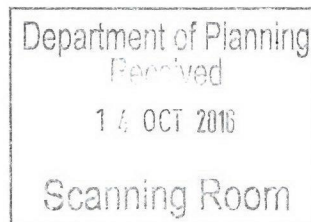
I live close to the train line and object to any further coal trains being railed past my front door.
