Dear Sir / Madam,

I oppose the Rocky Hill Coal Project and the Stratford Modification .

I moved up to Taree 5 years ago after I retired, having lived in western Sydney for 30 years. I was looking for somewhere quiet, clean and green. Very soon I found out about AGL's intended CSG project and the Rocky Hill Coal Project at Gloucester, just over an hour's pleasant drive away, which had the potential to seriously pollute the Manning River, the source of our drinking water.

Whatever safeguards the state government chooses to impose on this project, you only have to remember what happened at Bulga. The government can cancel any safeguards it wishes, despite two court decisions in favour of the residents at Bulga.

And the recent black lung disease outbreak in the Queensland coal mines demonstrates what happens when the safeguards are not enforced. Governments do not like to spend money enforcing regulations, preferring to receive large donations from mining companies.

Gloucester is too small for the government to install air monitoring equipment there, so the dust and pollution from the mine, on the very doorstep of Gloucester, will not be monitored nor controlled. And there will be coal dust from the waste heaps, as it does get windy at times out there.

What the government is doing approving any new coal mines is the real question. With the effects of climate change apparent around the world, the last thing the planet needs is another coal mine to add to the problem.

The future could be clean and green with appropriate investment in environmentally friendly renewable energy.

I have seen advice, reputedly from an American Indian chief, that it will not be until we have cut down the last tree, caught the last fish and poisoned the last stream that we will realise that we can't eat money.

Nor coal, for that matter.
