Back on 19 February 2016, I provided some comment on the subject SSD 7491 on behalf of the Local Office at DPI-Lands, and have recently been asked for comment.

I have received recent information from the Exhibition of SSD 7491, but apart from the NSW DPI submission which addressed groundwater, I have not found reference to addressing potential contamination to surface waters on which I commented in February 2016.

Given the proximity of the Facility to the Crown Waterway, Ropes Creek and that Biodiversity Lot C and Biodiversity Lot B, both drain to Ropes Creek, there would appear to be potential for downstream contamination, depending on how well the Facility is managed and how well accidents/spills etc are contained on the site.

These matters likely have already been addressed, but I forward them on, in case they have not yet been adequately covered.
