## Campbelltown Hospital Redevelopment Stage 2

Reference is made to correspondence dated 21 November 2018 seeking comments in relation to the above State Significant Development in accordance with the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The New South Wales Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) has reviewed the information provided and advises the following bush fire protection measures be applied to the development:

## Water and Utilities

The intent of measures is to provide adequate services of water for the protection of buildings during and after the passage of a bush fire, and to locate gas and electricity so as not to contribute to the risk of fire to a building.

1. Water, electricity and gas are to comply with section 4.1.3 and 4.2.7 of *Planning for Bush Fire Protection (PBP)* 2006.

## **Evacuation and Emergency Planning**

The intent of the measures is to provide suitable emergency and evacuation (and relocation) arrangements for occupants of special fire protection purpose developments.

2. A Bush Fire Emergency Management and Evacuation Plan shall be prepared consistent with *Development Planning- A Guide to Developing a Bush Fire Emergency Management and Evacuation Plan December 2014.*
