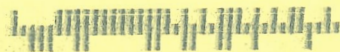

I object to the proposal for the following reasons:

1. There was no prior community consultation before the announcement.
2. Closing other schools to develop a campus in the business centre of town will impact on our already clogged streets. Major new subdivisions and population growth are located west of the town and utilise the existing newish, purpose built Wollumbin High School. Closing this school and bussing children into town makes no sense and will have a major negative impact on streets that are already clogged especially when school commences and finishes.
3. East Murwillumbah school, because it is impacted by flooding, could be relocated to Wollumbin High precinct as this is a relatively new flood free campus located near population growth areas. Apart from flooding the school has a really good reputation.
4. School outcomes are impacted by reduced staff numbers and many students will not thrive in such a large school.
5. Construction vehicles will impact severely on the main street of town, the bridge, Wollumbin, Riverview and Nullum Streets, which are already not coping with the traffic.
6. Noise pollution and construction activity will also affect the amenity of our home and neighbourhood.
7. The main bus thoroughfare to the school, being Nullum St, is severely affected by flooding and the Riverview St frontage is unusable for buses so kids can't get to school when there is even minor flooding.
