Western Sydney Stadium Concept Proposal
and Stage 1 Demolition.

Object 1. I object to the staged decommission
and demolition of the existing
Parramatta War Memorial Swimming
Centre.

This swimming centre is a resource
provided by the Parramatta Commu-
nity in 1958/59 as a commemoration
of 2nd World War RAIF servicemen
and women, such as my Six
Uncles and Aunts and my Dad.

In 2010/2011 \$7.5 million of ^{my} our rate
payers money was invested
in upgrading the pool to a
world class standard.

I believe that the proposal to
have a 30,000 seat stadium
and ancillary services can be
located without affecting or
demolishing the Parramatta War
Memorial Swimming Centre.

This was achieved in the
design of Parramatta Stadium

as a 26,000 capacity stadium,
in 1984/86.

Objection 2. I object to a concept design for a new stadium, it goes beyond and above the design parameters set to preserve the ~~the~~ material and visual effect of ~~the~~ a 5 tier, 43 metre high stadium on the World Heritage quality of Parnamatta Park.

This objection includes any impact on the view scape from Old Government House and within Parnamatta Park. This was the design criteria set for Parnamatta stadium in 1984/86.

Objection 3. I object to any demolition of the Parnamatta War Memorial Swimming pool on the ground that no site has been determined environmentally or materially for the location and funding of an equivalent facility to Parnamatta War Memorial swimming Centre including a 10 lane 50 metre, outdoor pool, a Diving and water polo pool, an intermediate

pool and a babies pool.

The Parramatta War Memorial Swimming Centre is a very popular community asset with an average of 160,000 visitations per year. This exceeds the number of attendees at Parramatta Stadium.

This swimming centre enables our Parramatta community to learn to swim, to keep fit and to have outdoor recreation.

Objection 4

I object to any impact on the site of the first farm in the Colony of NSW at Parramatta. This site is on the northern bank of Parramatta Park and the southern end of the ^{existing} Parramatta Stadium.

This major heritage site is called Dadd's Farm site

Objection 5. I object to any use of the existing Parramatta Park ~~Trust~~ Crown land for the concept design for a 30,000 seat stadium, ancillary uses and car park or for Private Enterprise

such as Gambling outlets,
Hotels, alcohol outlets, such
as bottle shops.

Arramatta Park was set aside
in Colonial NSW days for
the public and community
use not to be privatised
and given over to private purposes
or uses.
