Water Quality:

The EIS states clearly that groundwater assessment was undertaken in accordance with regulations, methods and guidance documents:

However:

Paika Lake and Paika Creek are not mentioned at all.

Paika Lake is a 450 hectare wetland, (within close proximity to the property "Hughdale"), which supplies stock and domestic water to three properties, (Lake Paika, Dundomallee & Hobler's Lake).

Will there be regular water quality monitoring with reports supplied to the Landholders?
