Re: SSD 7090 Gunlake Extension Project

It is with great concern that I write to you about the above matter.

Gunlake Quarry Expansion involves a massive upgrade from the present situation and we learn from the Environmental Impact Statement with the Department of Planning that they intend to have 690 heavy vehicles travelling on the Brayton Road every day.

This is totally unacceptable. Brayton Road is a secondary country road which has already become a hazardous one for local people. To imagine that we could cope with 690 trucks per day is quite ridiculous. A rail link would appear to be the most sensible solution.

I understand the Holcim Quarry in our valley (which has built a rail link to keep their trucks off the road and the highway) has installed its crusher in a soundproof shed and this is obviously what Gunlake Quarry should do as well. Holcim has set a standard which has addressed all the concerns of the local community.

I believe the Gunlake Quarry should do the same.
