
I wish to lodge my objection to Application No SSD 7090 Gunlake Quarry Extension Project in its present form.

I feel there has not been enough heed taken to:

1. The increase in truck traffic on a road one lane each way (being Brayton Road and Bypass Road). I worry about the number of movements being an average of 440 a day, with a maximum of 690 trucks a day and the safety to the residents of the area using the roads at present.
2. It also seems that the crushing will be occurring 24 hours a day. This will create a large amount of noise and silica dust in the area. The crusher should be enclosed in a shed to minimise these problems. This has been done successfully by Lynwood Quarry (Holcim) but no undertaking by Gunlake.

Gunlake are seeking approval to expand their production by constructing and operating on a shoestring budget and with no consideration to local residents.
