I wish to lodge my objection to the Gunlake Quarry Expansion Project.

Gunlake Quarry plan to increase truck movements along Brayton Road and the Bypass Road from 164 trucks per day to 440 trucks per day, sometimes a maximum of 690 trucks per day. The trucks are to operate 24 hours a day.

Brayton Road and the Bypass Road cannot accommodate that many trucks for safety reasons. It is a school bus route. The road will be too dangerous for me to drive on day and night. I am almost 80 years old and have been a resident of Brayton Road for over 65 years.

The wildlife that will be killed on the road will be also be problem for all motorists to avoid

My other concern is the noise from the crusher that will be operating 24 hours a day. Mr O'Neil said at a community information meeting some time ago that he would put the crusher in a sound proof shed. There is no mention of that in Gunlake's Environmental Impact Statement. The locals cannot live with the noise from Gunlake's crusher 24 hours a day. Mr O'Neil's offer to double glaze windows of the homes of locals impacted is not a total solution to the noise either. We have to go outside.

I understand that Marulan is a quarrying area but Mr O'Neil must listen to the local community concerns and put in place the appropriate infrastructure if he wants to expand Gunlake's operation to 2 million tonnes of hard rock per year.
