Thank you for your letter notifying Sydney Water of the proposed development listed above. We have reviewed the application and provide the following comments for your consideration.

## Water and Wastewater

- The proposed lots will be serviced by a 150mm extension from the existing 375mm water main in Cowpasture Road.
- The proposed development will be served by wastewater extensions from the existing 315mm wastewater main in Newton Road.
- The proposed wastewater infrastructure for this development will be sized & configured according to the Sewerage Code of Australia WSA 02-2002-2.2 (Sydney Water Edition 1 – Version 3).
