Dear Sir

The project is necessary just that it is being built in the wrong place, to the east would have been a better option which would be a shorter route with better foundations.

My submission is on the present option, being the overpass of the highway at Byrons lane Tyndale to ensure adequate fencing of the ramps so that livestock can be driven safely over the highway. A double height of guard rail should be enough to have a fence of at least 1.6 meters in height the entire length of the ramps. The need to move cattle in this direction in flood time has occurred several times in past floods when there is no other option.

Before the recent floods there was a large emu population in the area of Byrons lane their only escape is towards the high ground of the river bank. The proposed highway and fencing could cut off this escape.

I have not got any benefit from the E.I.S. Statement in relation to any property as I do not have the time to persue an almost unreadable document.

I ask to be kept informed on these matters.
