

## Woolgoolga to Ballina – Extension to work hours during construction

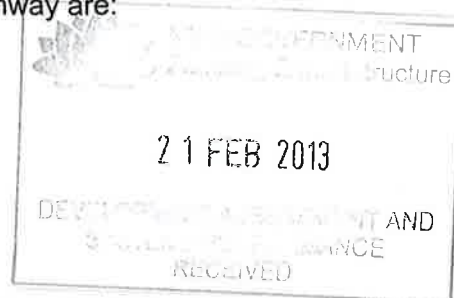
As part of the planning process for the upgrade project, RMS is seeking approval from the Department of Planning and Infrastructure to extend work hours during construction.

Standard construction hours for projects on the Pacific Highway are:

- Monday to Friday, between 7am to 6pm.
- Saturday, between 8am to 1pm.

The proposed hours are:

- Monday to Friday, between 6am to 7pm.
- Saturday, between 8am to 5pm.



Further information and detail on the noise impacts will be included in the Construction Noise and Vibration Assessment report which will be available to the public as part of the Environmental Impact Statement later this year.
