Recommendations

Should development consent of the Section 96(1A) modification application be approved and prior to commencement of construction of the proposed development, that the instrument of consent requires the preparation and submission of the following study:

1. A fire safety study for the proposed development. This study shall cover the relevant aspects of the Department of Planning & Environment's Hazardous Industry Planning Advisory Paper No. 2 'Fire safety Study Guidelines'. The study shall be submitted for approval to Fire & Rescue NSW.
2. To ensure that relevant hazards are identified, that the applicant consult with Fire & Rescue NSW prior to preparation of the fire safety study.
