Re: Sebastopol Solar Farm (SSD 0998)

Thank you for the opportunity to review and provide comment on the Sebastopol Solar Farm proposal (SSD 0998). Local Land Services provides consideration to and approval of clearing of native vegetation on regulated rural land under the *Local Land Services Act 2013*.

Clearing provisions under the Local Land Services Act 2013, section 60O states:

For the purposes of this Part, the clearing of native vegetation in a regulated rural area is authorised under other legislation in any of the following cases:

- (a) The clearing was authorised by
 - (i) a development consent under Part 4 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979, or
 - (ii) a State significant infrastructure approval under Part 5.1 of that Act

Therefore, as the proposed development will be assessed under Part 4 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, Local Land Services does not provide any additional consent for clearing of native vegetation.

Local Land Services note that the key biodiversity issues of concern have been considered in the EIS and have no further comment in respect to matters under Part 5A of the *Local Land Services Act 2013.*
