

## **WestConnex M4 East EIS issues**

In regard to the **Northcote street civil site (C7)**:

I don't want structures hard up against the boundary with my property. This includes but is not limited to Workshop, offices, sub stations, water treatment plants. In particular the **Acoustic SHED**. Being up to 10 metres tall this will cause excessive shadowing, blocking of skylight and daylight to my property. Spanning the whole length of our property and across Northcote street, it will grossly affect our visual amenity, we would feel like we were in a prison, trapped and enclosed. Visually thinking this would be a 10m tall 90 m long wall, which we would wake up to and be in our face every morning, noon and night for the next 3 years, this would leave one very depressed and who knows suicidal.

My expectation would be that the acoustic shed and other structures are 20m from the boundary as per layout figure 6.15 page 6-35 EIS volume 1A part 4. Also, considering the proximity to residential properties the acoustic shed should not be taller than 8 metres.

Furthermore, We don't want any fuel(refill station), chemical or explosive storage areas near the boundary with my property.

On the boundary with my property I don't want the hoarding to be greater than 2.5 to 3.0 m maximum in height, this will cause excessive shadowing, blocking of skylight and daylight to my property. Also, it will grossly affect our visual amenity. It should also be set back from the boundary.

Driveway access: reversing out of my driveway will be difficult with the hoarding fence placed on the boundary across Northcote street , please allow space or an area so we may reverse out of our driveway.
