I would like to lodge my objection to the proposed changed to the rail link from Beecroft to the City via Macquarie Park. I actually work in North Ryde and the current regular service from Hornsby via Epping then Chatswood is ideal. It's part of the reason for moving to Beecroft.

Since moving to Beecroft and using this direct service I have reduced my car usage to work from daily to at most once every two weeks. It's a major contributing factor to our family reducing the number of cars in a four adult home from three to two.

My friends call me a "public transport fanatic" and I do believe the Epping - Chatswood line is a valuable addition to our rail network.
